You may use a mat from a previous year as long as there are no tears or tape. Due to limited storage, we request **NO sleeping bags, exercise mats or rolled mats.**
 - **A small blanket and pillow (TRAVEL SIZE):** These will be used for rest time. Due to limited storage, we request **NO bed pillows or large blankets!** Items must be able to fit into a reusable tote, anything larger cannot be accepted.

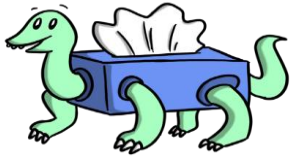

- Diapers or Pull-Ups, and diaper cream** (with completed Medication Consent Form).

- Water bottle or Sippy Cup:** Please provide a fresh bottle of water each day for your child. It will need to go home to be cleaned daily. Fresh water is provided for all students.
- Formula (Wiggly Warriors Only):** Supplied by parent, clearly labelled, and stored in the room.
- A backpack OR diaper bag:** for carrying papers, notices, and artwork home.
- Please bring the following for class and note that more may be needed throughout the year. (For your information, Mount Hope will also supply Force of Nature products for sanitizing surfaces):**
 - 2 large boxes of tissues**
 - 6 packages of baby wipes**
