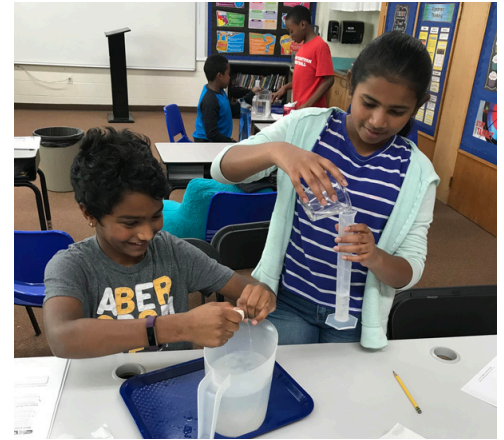

Transitional Kindergarten, Kindergarten - Grade 5

Preschool

2 years 9 months - 5 Years

Tuition

The school year begins in September with similar holidays and vacations to public school. Please reference current school calendar for specific dates. All school payments are made through FACTS. An annual fee of \$20-\$50 will be charged by FACTS depending on the payment plan chosen.

Discounts

Sibling: Applied to families with 2 or more students enrolled (excluding Toddlers). Second youngest child will receive 10% off, additional children will receive 20% off.

Pastoral: 15% (Credentialed Active Pastor)

Military: 15% (Active Duty Military)

Extended Care (Elementary & Preschool)

Starting at 7:30am until school day begins

Ending at 5:00pm from when school day ends

This Program is available to all Preschool & Elementary students. Enrollment information, including fee structure and registration, will be sent out prior to the beginning of the school year.

Referral Discount

You could be eligible to receive a tuition discount by providing referrals.

- Refer up to 3 families who have not been previously enrolled, \$500 per family (max \$1,500 per school year)
- Referred child must enroll and list your name
- Referral amounts are per family not per student
- Discounts are posted monthly and only for the months the referred family is enrolled
- May be used for school related expenses only - not transferable and not redeemable for cash

Financial Aid

Need-based financial aid is available for qualified families. MHCS employs FACTS Grant and Aid Assessment, a third party, to perform a financial need analysis for all financial aid requests. The Financial Aid Committee at MHCS then uses this information to make the final decision on financial aid awards.

Please note, families are only eligible to apply for financial aid once student(s) enrollment is complete. Financial Aid is not offered for our Early Childhood Program.

Application Process

Apply online through your Family Portal (found at our website) under the Financial tab. The FACTS online application has all the forms and requirements that must be completed in order to be considered for financial aid. A \$40 non-refundable fee is required to submit your application.

Incomplete applications will not be considered for aid.

Deadlines

The deadline for receipt of completed financial aid materials is March 31st. Materials received after this date are processed on a rolling basis, subject to the availability of funds.

- TK EMPHASIZES SOCIAL SKILLS, HELPING CHILDREN LEARN TO INTERACT WITH PEERS, SHARE AND FOLLOW CLASSROOM RULES.

- SUCCESS IN A LESS FORMAL SETTING BOOSTS CHILDREN'S CONFIDENCE, POSITIVELY IMPACTING THEIR ATTITUDE TOWARDS LEARNING.
